John Smith (AgriLife Extension) reviewed the TWON training schedule. There were four one-hour events held in the last quarter with 93 attendees. One day events were held in Weatherford, Caldwell, Lampasas, and Seguin, with a combined total of 126 attendees.

TGPC Website Activity Statistics

Peggy Hunka (TCEQ) reviewed the Google Analytics activity report on the TGPC web page, which showed that in the previous quarter there was a 12% increase in the number of users and a 2.8% increase in the average number of pages viewed per session.
