CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

Joel Pigg (AgriLife Extension), Co-Chair of the TGPC POE Subcommittee, called the meeting to order at 1:03 p.m. Attendees were introduced. The minutes were provided to the members by email for review prior to the meeting.

Recent and Upcoming Outreach Events

The current Outreach Events Status Report was reviewed, and is available on the POE Subcommittee webpage, https://tgpc.texas.gov/tgpc-subcommittees/tgpc-public-outreach-and-education-subcomittee/ under the "Additional Resources" heading:

- · AgriLife Extension Service Water Well Screening:
 - Joel Pigg (AgriLife Extension) reported that one event was held in Llano County where 43 samples were analyzed. He also reported that AgriLife staff were in Brooks, Jim Hogg, Kleberg, Jim Wells counties; and that later this week they would be in Duval, Nueces, Bee, and Live Oak. To date AgriLife has collected 200 water samples from attendees. Future events are planned for October.
- · TGPC Exhibit Booth:

The TCEQ Environmental Trade Fair and Conference was held May 10-11 in Austin, Texas. The TGPC booth had approximately 214 visitors. The next booth will be at the TCEQ Public Drinking Water Conference in August.

TWON Training Activities

Joel Pigg (AgriLife Extension) reviewed the TWON training schedule. During the previous quarter, one hour-long event was held in Llano with 46 attendees. Three one-day events were held in Cleburne, Midland and Odessa with 43 attendees. During the past year there have been 979 attendees at TWON events.

TGPC Website Activity Statistics

Peggy Hunka (TCEQ) reviewed the Google Analytics activity report on the TGPC web page, which showed that in the previous quarter there was an 19% increase in the number of users and a 4% increase in the average number of pages viewed per session. Organic searches show that 716 users arrived at the site by typing in the address, and that most visitors used Google search to find the TGPC website.
