• AgriLife Extension Service Water Well Screening:

John Smith (AgriLife Extension) reported that one event was held in February in Anderson County and 15 samples were analyzed. Upcoming events will be held in Llano and Concho counties in May.

• TGPC Exhibit Booth:

There were no booth activities. The poster for National Groundwater Awareness Week was distributed to all member agencies and organizations earlier this year for posting on their social media platforms.

TWON Training Activities

John Smith (AgriLife Extension) reviewed the TWON training schedule. There was one one-hour event held in in the last quarter with 15 attendees and no one-day events.

TGPC Website Activity Statistics

Peggy Hunka (TCEQ) reviewed the Google Analytics activity report on the TGPC web page, which showed that in the previous quarter there was a 8% increase in the number of users and a 5% increase in the average number of pages viewed per session. Organic searches shows that 822 users arrived at the site by typing in the address, and that most visitors used Google search to find the TGPC website.

- If PFAS is everywhere, how do I avoid it? PFAS is an emerging issue and may be good to start working on this FAQ.
