Texas Groundwater Protection Committee (TGPC) Groundwater Issues (GWI) Subcommittee Annual Report October 18, 2017

This Annual Report is provided as per the TGPC GWI Subcommittee ("Subcommittee") *Charge*¹.

Fiscal Year 2017 Results

- The Subcommittee met four times during the past fiscal year:
 - September 14, 2016;
 - o December 14, 2016;
 - o March 8, 2017; and,
 - o June 7, 2017.
- At their meetings, the Subcommittee received reports from its Agricultural Chemicals Task Force, tracked the status of the TGPC's publications, and discussed the following groundwater-related issues:
 - Water Supply Enhancement Program
 - Hydraulic Fracturing
 - o Freshwater Mussels
 - Emerging Contaminants
 - o Saline Groundwater Trends and Impacts in Texas
 - Agricultural Chemicals
 - o Priority Groundwater Management Areas (PGMAs)
 - o Border Groundwater
 - o Aquifer Storage and Recovery
 - Abandoned Water Wells
 - Failing Septic Systems
 - Others (e.g., the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) Brackish Resources Aquifer Characterization System (BRACS) program)

- The Subcommittee developed and approved the following white papers:
 - The Process for Independent Data Sources to Submit Information to the TGPC for Consideration in PGMA Studies²; and,
 - o How Do Changing Groundwater Conditions Affect Freshwater Mussels?
- The Subcommittee reviewed and provided feedback on the existing Railroad Commission of Texas (RRC) Hydraulic Fracturing Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) and Class II injection well cross-sectional diagram.
- The Subcommittee reviewed its *Charge* and did not have any changes to recommend to the TGPC.
- The Subcommittee developed and approved its *Fiscal Year 2018 2019 Activity Plan*³.
- The Subcommittee formed a Task Force in order to prepare a draft update of the *Texas Groundwater Protection Strategy* ("*Strategy*") ⁴ for subsequent member review.

- The Subcommittee will continue development of the following white papers:
 - Health Impacts of Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS)-Contaminated Groundwater
 - o Border Groundwater
 - Aquifer Storage and Recovery
